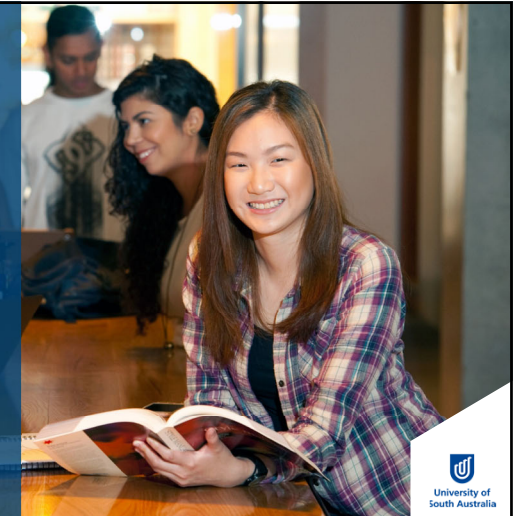

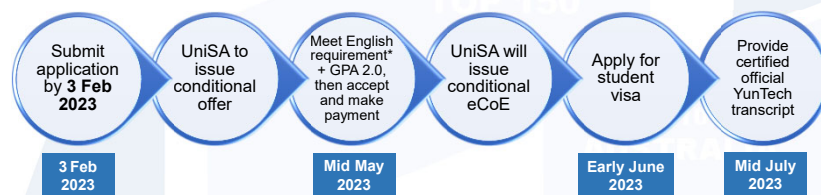
INTERNATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

Recipients will receive a 15% reduction in their tuition fees for the duration of the chosen degree

- 70%+ academic result at YunTech
- Automatically assessed with final transcript
- Must study minimum 2 years onshore at UniSA (72 credit units)
- Maintain GPA 4.5+ for continuing receive the scholarship payment the year after
- Can save more than A\$10,000 in 2 years

FAQ

1. Can I choose other objective English tests other than IELTS

- Yes, UniSA also accepts PTE and TOEFL
- PTE: 50 (Reading and Writing not less than 50)
 - TOEFL iBT: 60 (Reading and Writing not less than 18)

2. What if I cannot achieve the required English entry requirement for direct entry?

- Students could request for English language course package – CELUSA
- For example: 10-week English package would be required prior to UniSA UG study if with IELTS 5.5 average

3. Can I stay and work in Australia after graduate at UniSA?

- This 3+1+1 partnership between YunTech and UniSA allows students to apply for a 3-years Post Study Working Visa (PSWV) to stay and work in Adelaide after 2-year study
- Whereas study abroad/ exchange program could not be counted as these are non-award programs in Australia

4. If I am being accepted and going to study at UniSA, do I still need to finish my final year with YunTech?

- YES! Please be reminded the requirement of progressing to UniSA Master of Management (the 2nd year) will be:
- Bachelor Degree graduate certificate and final transcript from YunTech
