Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- Academically motivated high school students or high school graduates

Application Materials

- 1 Copy of Academic Transcript
- 2 Copy of Passport
- 3 Proof of Health Insurance
- 4 Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian (only for pre-college students)
- 5 Proof of Financial Support

- 2 Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000 (non-refundable)
- 3 Send the required documents to isc@korea.ac.kr
- 4 Receive 'Letter of Acceptance' via email
- 5 Pay tuition fee and all other remaining fees
