## What is Semester@CPP and Why Apply?

The Semester@CPP program is a study abroad experience for international students around the world to study at Cal Poly Pomona for one or two semesters (four months to one year) without having to be matriculated. With the program students will:

- Enroll in degree-credit courses at Cal Poly Pomona and study alongside other American students
- Choose from 3000+ credit courses from various areas
- Get academic transcripts carrying all the credit units by completing your courses
- Transfer credit units back to your home university towards your degree, or apply the credit units to your future degree study at Cal Poly Pomona or other universities
- Explore your independent nature and experience more opportunities
- Prep for graduate school admission or enhance job prospects

### Tuition and Other Fees

- Program tuition: \$5,900 (including 12 credit units)
- Application fee: \$175
- Health insurance for international students: \$550 per semester
