# Information of Exchange Program for 2021 Spring Semester

### Program Objective

The objective of the Exchange Program for students from partner universities is to provide international exchange students with the opportunity to acquire the experience of living and studying in our campus. ### Qualifications

Prospective applicant must meet the following criteria;

### Duration of Stay

Students may choose to enroll for one semester of the study program under the agreement between Hanbat National University and the Partner University.

### Student VISA Information

The offer of admission to HBNU's exchange student program DOES NOT come with the student VISA which is strictly required by the Korean Immigration Department for students to enter and study in Republic of Korea.

Application of VISA approval and payment of related immigration charges can be done via the Korean Embassy.
